During a Public Health Emergency



Casa de la Luz recognizes the important role family plays in our patients' end-of-life journey and we are committed to allowing safe, limited participation in staff home visits. We are equally committed to maintaining a safe environment for all Casa de la Luz patients, visitors and staff. To minimize the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) and in accordance with CDC guidelines, Governor Ducey Executive Order 2020-52 and Pima County Board of Supervisors Resolution 2020-49 we have instituted the following policies:

1. Face coverings are required for families and visitors at all times while the Casa de la Luz staff member is visiting the patient and in the home.
2. Only one (1) designated family member is present in the room with the patient while we assess and complete the visit and observe appropriate social distancing. The Casa de la Luz staff member will update that family member and is happy to do a telehealth visit for our family members. We request limited family members be present during our visits in order to comply with the Pima County ordinance of 10 people or less.

We appreciate your support as we strive to continue offering safe home visits to all Casa de la Luz patients.
